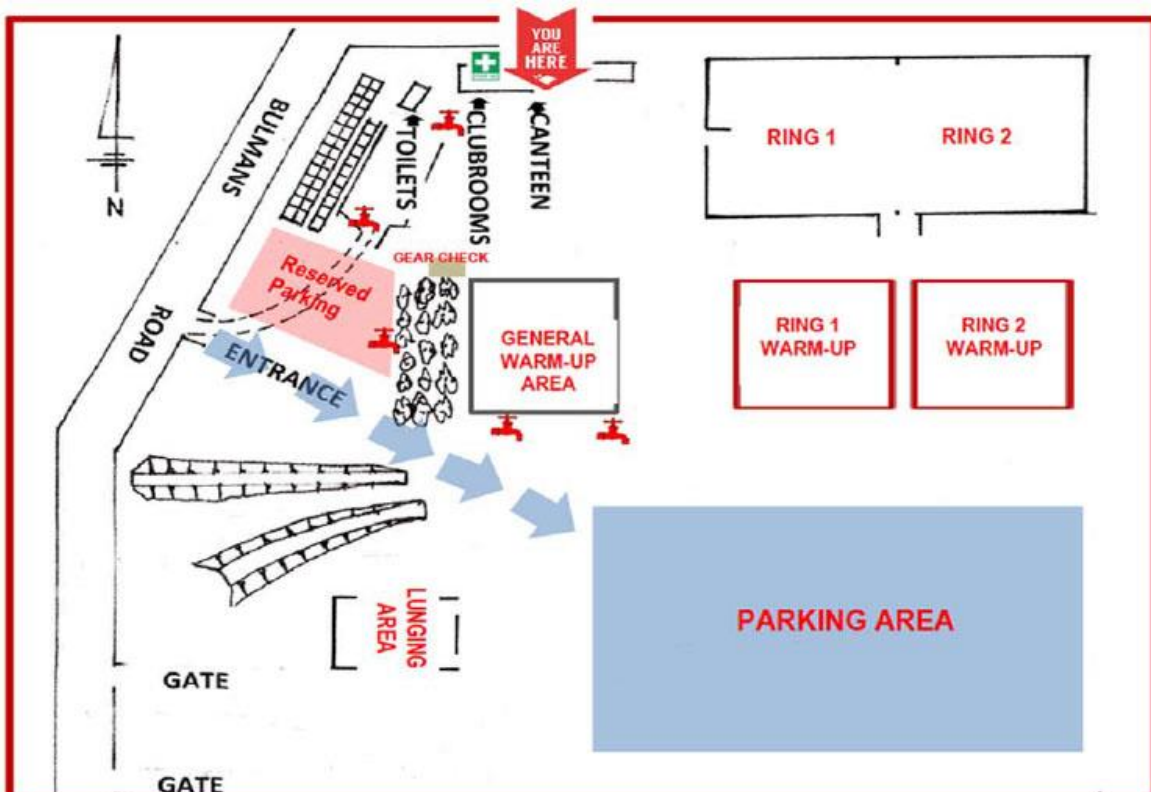
WELCOME...

OPEN RIDERS...

PCAV Day Participant Waiver & Declaration Form

ALL riders competing in the OPEN section MUST submit a completed PCAV Day Participant Waiver & Declaration Form. Please remember to include the Equine Association you are a member of, along with your current membership number.

Proof of Equine Association Membership

ALL riders competing in the OPEN section MUST show/provide proof of relevant Equine Association membership. If no proof is shown/provided, rider will be required to pay a \$10 Day Participant Fee (as per PCAV Rules).

Equestrian Association = EV/EA; AHS; SHCA; AERA; an Interstate Pony Club; or can prove personal Liability Cover of at least \$10,000,000. (Must produce proof)

PCAV RIDERS...

PCAV Club Member Cards

Any pony club member who does not present an accurate PCAV club member card or lodge a fully completed verification form that proves the PCAV eligibility requirements will be disqualified. It is your responsibility to ensure that your PCAV club member card is accurate and presented to the organising committee on the day. Note that D.C's may not alter or correct grading at the competition. If you are not sure on how a PCAV club member card must be completed, please read the Club Member Cards Guidelines.

Verification Forms

If you have a lost or damaged card, you may present a fully completed verification form to the competition in accordance with the PCAV Handbook of By-Laws. The organising committee will not supply verification forms. Verification forms may not be used as an attempt to over-ride membership card inaccuracies.

ALL RIDERS...

PCAV Rules Apply

This competition is run under PCAV Rules as per the PCAV Handbook of By-Laws and PCAV Show Jumping Rules. Please make sure you read these rules before querying any decisions.

Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCAV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.

Medical Arm Bands

Must be worn by all competitors. If you do not have one, get creative with a mobile phone arm band or similar and just insert your medical details.

No medical arm band, no taking part in the competition!

PCAV Gear Rules

PCAV Gear Rules apply to this competition – please ensure all gear (rider and horse) complies with PCAV Gear Rules.

ALL riders must Gear Check 30min prior to riding time.

NO GEAR CHECK – AUTOMATIC ELIMINATION

Entrant Number

ALL riders are to provide their own bridle/saddle blanket numbers. Numbers must be displayed on both sides of the horse/pony.

Helmets

All riders must have correct standards numbers in accordance with PCAV Gear Rules, spot checks may be conducted at the competition. An incorrect helmet will result in disqualification from the competition.

Horses

Horses entered in show jumping must be at least age four. Strictly **NO STALLIONS, COLTS** or RIGS

Lunging

Lunging at this competition must take place in the confined area designated exclusively for lunging, by the organizing committee. At a competition only the competitor may ride or lunge his horse or pony. The penalty for disobeying this rule is elimination.

Disclaimer of Liability

Neither the Organising Committee of this event nor the PCAV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, grounds, spectators or any other person or property.

Reservation of Right

The Organising Committee reserves the right to:

- Cancel any class or event
- Divide any class
- Alter the advertised times
- Refuse an entry, with or without stating the reason.

No Pets

Strictly NO DOGS or other pets allowed on grounds.

Results

Scores become final 30 minutes after the last score in the section has been posted. Scores announced while the competition is still in progress are subject to confirmation.

The time of posting must be written on the scoresheet.

Protests & Queries

A query may be lodged to question an incident rather than lodge a formal protest.

Query Forms are available at the Office. If you are not satisfied with the answer to your query, you may lodge a formal protest in accordance with the PCAV Handbook of By-Laws.

PARKING...

As you come through the entrance gates, veer right and follow the gravel internal roadway out onto the cross country course.

If you have a horse yard reserved, your parking area is to the left as you come through the entrance gates.

The gate attendant will check your name off the list and direct you through.

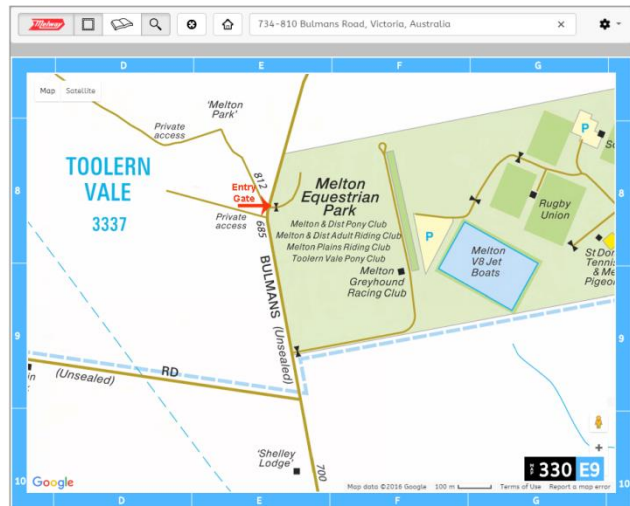
LOCATION MAP...
